I understand and accept the fact that alpine skiing/snowboarding in its various forms is a hazardous sport that has many dangers and risks. I realize that injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence of this sport. I agree, as a condition of being allowed to use the ski area facility and premises, that I freely accept and voluntarily assume all risks of personal injury or death or property damage, and release Butternut Basin, Inc., and its agents, and Directors, Officers and Shareholders from any and all liability for personal injury or property damage which results in any way from negligence and conditions on or about the premises, facilities, the operations of the area including, but not limited to, grooming, snowmaking, lift operations, actions or omissions of employees or agents of the area, or my participation in skiing, snowboarding, or other activities at the area. In addition, if I am choosing to rent equipment for myself or as parent/guardian, I accept for use AS IS the equipment listed on this form or Rental records, and accept full financial responsibility for the care of the equipment while it is in my possession. I understand that the binding system cannot guarantee the user's safety. In downhill skiing, the binding system will not release at all times or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release. In snowboarding, skiboarding and snowblade use, the binding system will not release as a result of forces generated during ordinary operation. I understand that the sport of skiing, snowboarding, snowblading, skiboarding and other recreational activities involve inherent and other risks of INJURY and DEATH, I voluntarily agree to expressly assume all risks or injury or death that may result from skiing/snowboarding from skiing/snowboarding/snowblade use or which relate in any way to the use of this equipment. I AGREE TO RELEASE the Butternut Rental Shop, Butternut Basin, Inc., its employees, owners, affiliates, agents, officers, directors, and the manufacturer and distributors of this equipment (collectively "Providers") from all liability from injury, death, property loss and damage which results from the equipment user's participation in the sport of skiing/snowboarding/snowblading and skiboarding use, or is in any way related to use of this equipment. This agreement is governing to the applicable law of the State of Massachusetts. If any provision of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other provisions shall be given full force and effect.

Ski Butternut invites students from the Berkshire Hills Regional School District to participate in the following specially discounted ski and snowboard programs. The options available to students are listed and explained below:

LESSON SKI / SNOWBOARD PROGRAM - This program is designed for skiers and snowboarders of all abilities. Program includes; transportation from the Berkshire Hills schools to Butternut, **8 lessons (see dates below)** lasting approximately 1 1/2 hours and any time remaining after the lesson will be free ski/board time. The students are also invited to free ski/snowboard on Saturday March 5th and Sunday March 6th. Lessons **WILL NOT** be offered on this weekend.

LESSON PROGRAM WITH RENTAL- If the a student **DOES NOT** have his/her own equipment he or she has the option to rent Ski Butternut's for an additional cost of \$50. This equipment is **ONLY** available for the student on the day of the afternoon lessons + the last weekend session on March 5th and 6th. Lessons **WILL NOT** be offered this weekend, however, students are invited to use the facility and equipment on these days.

Please indicate skier or snowboarder and the student's height, weight, shoe size as well as skier type.

FREE / REDUCED LUNCH PROGRAM WITH OR WITHOUT RENTALS - Available to families who qualify for the free/reduced lunch program at school. Eligibility is determined by District guidelines. Please understand, this is **PRIVELEDGED** information, Ski Butternut cannot request this information from the school. Each child must have **PROOF OF ELIGIBILITY** to obtain this rate by providing the **ORIGINAL PROOF** form from school with the official stamp.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- *Please be advised that students will be on their own for the free ski time.
- *Children are divided into lesson groups according to their age *and* ability.
- *Should a lesson day be missed due to inclement weather or other unforeseeable occurrences, Ski Butternut does its' best to make up the lesson, added on to the end of the last scheduled Tuesday or Thursday.
- All Students enrolled in the lesson program are invited to free ski Saturday and Sunday March 5th and 6th. Lessons WILL NOT be offered these days but students may use the facilities and rented equipment for the day.**
- *Students of any age requiring special services will receive lessons on Thursdays only.
- *Parents are responsible for transportation to and from Ski Butternut for the weekend session.

CLASSIFICATION FOR SKIER TYPE - Determining your skiing ability is your responsibility. Your skier type, height, age and boot sole length

are used by the Rental Shop to determine the release/retention settings of your ski bindings. Be sure to provide accurate information; any error may increase your risk of injury. Consult these descriptions to select your classification.
