I. Know and Follow **SMART STYLE – PARK SMART** Terrain Park Safety Program

START SMALL - Work your way up. Build your skills. Never stop below a feature.

MAKE A PLAN - Every feature. Every time. Always scope out before trying.

ALWAYS LOOK - Before you drop. Wait your turn. Be cognizant of others.

RESPECT - The features and other users. Never cut off other skiers and riders.

TAKE IT EASY - Know your limits. Land on your feet. Avoid inverted maneuvers.

FREESTYLE TERRAIN

◀ This Orange Oval symbol designates Freestyle Terrain such as parks and pipes. Smart Style represents Freestyle Terrain safety. Know it, Respect it, Use it!

Make a plan.
Every time you use freestyle terrain, make a plan for each feature you want to use. Your speed, approach and take off will directly affect your maneuver and landing.

Look before you leap.
Scope around the jumps first, not over them. Know landings are clear, and clear yourself out of the landing area.

Easy style it.
Start small and work your way up. (Inverted aerials not recommended).

Respect gets respect.
From the lifeline through the park.

II. Know **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE** – (This is a Partial List of Your Responsibilities)

1. Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.
4. Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails & out of closed areas.
7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely
