### I. Know and Follow **SMART STYLE – PARK SMART** Terrain Park Safety Program

- START SMALL** - Work your way up. Build your skills. Never stop below a feature.
- MAKE A PLAN** - Every feature. Every time. Always scope out before trying.
- ALWAYS LOOK** - Before you drop. Wait your turn. Be cognizant of others.
- RESPECT** - The features and other users. Never cut off other skiers and riders.
- TAKE IT EASY** - Know your limits. Land on your feet. Avoid inverted maneuvers.

◀ This Orange Oval symbol designates Freestyle Terrain such as parks and pipes. Smart Style represents Freestyle Terrain safety. Know it, Respect it, Use it!

**Make a plan.**  
Every time you use freestyle terrain, make a plan for each feature you want to use. Your speed, approach and take off will directly affect your maneuver and landing.

**Look before you leap.**  
Scope around the jumps first, not over them. Know landings are clear, and clear yourself out of the landing area.

**Easy style it.**  
Start small and work your way up. (Inverted aerials not recommended).

**Respect gets respect.**  
From the lifeline through the park.

### II. Know **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE** – (This is a Partial List of Your Responsibilities)

1. Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.
4. Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails & out of closed areas.
7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely

**III. Acknowledgement and Acceptance of RISKS & HAZARDS:**

The below named Participant, and the Parent or Permanent Legal Guardian of the Participant (if the Participant is under the age of 18), hereafter collectively referred to as "Participant", recognizes, understands, and agrees to accept all risks involved with participating in any activity at Ski Butternut. Participant understands that riding chairlifts, skiing or snowboarding anywhere on the mountain, entering the Terrain Parks, and/or using any of the features in the Terrain Parks are inherently dangerous activities with significant risks of property damage, personal injury, and/or death.

As a condition of use of the Terrain Park, Participant agrees to solely assume 100% of these risks including but not limited to:

- \* Riding the lifts
- \* Collisions with other persons and/or objects
- \* Equipment failure and/or malfunction
- \* Variations in terrain, surface or sub surface snow, ice conditions, bare spots, and other hazardous conditions
- \* Terrain park features such as jumps, rails, boxes, natural elements, and other features
- \* Rocks, trees, stumps, ditches, brush, and other forms of natural forest growth and debris
- \* Snowmaking equipment, water pipes, hydrants, hoses, towers, guns, and other equipment
- \* Vehicles, machines, grooming machines, snowmobiles, snow rakes, shovels, and other equipment
- \* Lift towers and lift tower components, whether above or below surface
- \* Intentionally or unintentionally becoming inverted during a maneuver (further increases the risk of severe injury)
- \* Any and all unforeseen risks that could potentially arise

**IV. Agreement to COMPLY WITH RULES:**

- \* Ride the lifts, ski, snowboard, and use the terrain park features at your own risk
- \* Stay clear of all snowmaking & grooming equipment, vehicles, towers, poles, and any other object on mountain
- \* Maintain control of speed, course, and body position at all times
- \* Stay in control and never ski or snowboard recklessly
- \* Avoid collision with any other skiers, persons, and/or any other objects on the mountain
- \* Abide by "Your Responsibility Code" and all posted signs and warnings
- \* Never ski out of bounds or on closed trails
- \* Avoid inverted aerial maneuvers and understand that such maneuvers greatly increase the possibility of catastrophic injury or death
- \* Abide by the Smart Style – Park Smart safety program listed on the reverse page
- \* Violation of the rules may result in revocation of Terrain Park Pass, Lift Ticket and/or Season Pass revoked without refund.
